DSI will soon begin screening professionals by appointment only

Dear Business Relation,

DSI Screening downscaling update

In November 2021, we informed you of the DSI Foundation Board's decision to scale down DSI's screening activities in 2022. Starting from 1 April 2022, DSI will stop screening professionals if the screening is not part of a certification request. This update explains how DSI will scale down its screening activities step-by-step until 1 April 2022.

Before 17:30 on 18 February 2022: no changes

Professionals can begin a DSI screening themselves via MijnDSI until 17:30 on 18 February 2022. You can also send a professional an invitation link to begin a screening. DSI will process both types of requests until the end of business on 18 February 2022.

Professionals will no longer be able to begin a screening themselves between 17:31 on 18 February 2022 and 1 April 2022.

From that time, DSI will no longer process screening requests initiated by the professional in MijnDSI. The only requests accepted will be those for which the professional was invited by your company. One benefit of the invitation link is that the screening request is directly linked with your company.

How can you send professionals an invitation?

Your company has access to the [MijnDSI portal](#), and MijnDSI features an invitation module. You can use this module to invite an individual professional or group of professionals to request a DSI screening. The module sends the professional(s) an e-mail inviting them to begin a screening process by clicking on an invitation link in the mail. The screening is directly linked to your company.

DSI has created a special user manual for employers to explain how the invitation module works.

DSI may not have a contract with the specific recruiters and recruitment & selection bureaus.

That means they do not have access to the MijnDSI portal and cannot use the invitation module. As a result, the professionals these bureaus represent will not be able to request DSI screenings after 17:30 on 18 February 2022.

Naturally, these bureaus are free to contact Validata to discuss a possible partnership.

If the recruiters and/or recruitment & selection bureaus submit more than 10 screening requests per month, then they may be eligible for a temporary DSI Screening contract until 1 April 2022. For more information, please send an e-mail to: relatiebeheer@dsi.nl.

After 1 April 2022

Starting from 1 April 2022, DSI will stop processing screening requests if the screening is not part of a DSI certification request. Validata would be happy to contact you to discuss a potential partnership.
